



The Calligraphy Expansion for Japanese: The Game is our first advanced-level expansion. Calligraphy in Japan is called 書道 (shodou) and is an incredibly important part of Japanese culture. Shodou is taught starting in elementary school and features in national contests. This expansion features the brushwork of Yamasaki Sho as the only information on the card, shown with all of the original detail to maintain the spirit of Yamasaki Sho. At the top of each kanji listing below, you'll see the kanji in the following formats: calligraphic, brush-style, and block-style.

You can play the cards as any word that can be made with one of the kanji as long as it does not require another kanji, such as 立てる *tateru* – to set up. Simply play the card 立 and declare that it's "tateru" on your turn. We've color-coded the words in this document by part of speech so you'll know if the word you're playing is a noun, verb, adjective, etc. You can also combine the cards to make larger words with multiple kanji (called "jukugo"). Jukugo are worth one point for each card they contain. For example, 愛書家 is a jukugo you can make with the cards in this deck which would be worth three points. Jukugo are unbreakable, and in competitive mode they must be removed from the table as a single word even when they're worth a lot of points.


